Life Group #8: Amazed Review

Objectives: In our busy lives we far too often just rush off to the next thing. This week we want to reflect on what we have discussed the past 8 weeks and allow people a chance to process what God has been doing in their lives. We want people to be reminded of how amazing Jesus is, and kindle a desire to know and follow Him. We want to come alongside one another and help each other know Christ more.

For the leaders- By now you should know the people in your group fairly well. This is a good study for you to creatively engage your group with the objectives. If these questions are helpful, then use them. If not, feel the freedom to do this review in a way that best engages your group. If you do something different and it works well, please pass it on to us so we can use it in a future Life Group!

Launch Use your own words... (5 minutes) If you were at the first life group we spent most of our time discussing a question Jesus asked in Matthew 16- "Who do you say that I am?".

- Do you think that this is a worthy question to discuss? Why or why not?
- Another way to ask this is, what happens if we do not have a correct view of who Jesus is?

Since that first Life Group we have looked at 6 different passages that help us discover who Jesus is. We discovered:

- He is an amazing savior who died on the cross for us. (Luke 23)
- He has amazing power as he takes Simon on a life altering fishing trip. (Luke 5)
- We see his amazing forgiveness in his interaction with the woman caught in adultery. (John 8)
- We see his amazing love as he washes the disciples feet and sends them out to do the same. (John 13)
- In Luke 14 we see what it takes to be his disciple. Jesus has amazing

- worth, but the cost is high to follow Him, so he tells us to count the cost.
- Last week we learned about his amazing pursuit from the parables in Luke 15. We learn that he loves people so much that all of heaven rejoices when one sinner repents and follows Christ.

Explore (discuss in small groups)

- As you reflect on these passages, how has your view of Jesus grown?
- Is there a specific passage that caused you to be amazed, encouraged or convicted?

Apply

- What is one way you plan to continue to grow in knowing Christ?
- If there was one thing we could do to help you know Christ more, what would it be?
- How could we pray for you as you seek to know Christ?
- Who are people you would like to see know Christ? Pray in small groups for each person.

To end we want to pray a prayer that is found in the Bible.
Read Ephesians 3:14-21
Have a few people pray a piece of the passage.
